- Space is limited to 100 people per week.

Accommodations are available at the Glacier Mountaineer Lodge and at the base of the gondola, and at the Palliser Lodge, nearby (ski-in, ski-out).

\$233	1-bedroom Suite (single or dbl. occupancy)
\$268	1-bedroom loft, 2-bedroom (single to quad occ.)

E.g. : A 2-bedroom suite for 5 nights with quad occupancy

(5 X \$268 ÷ 4 people = \$335 per person + fees/taxes)

Additional 18+ yrs. occupants over room capacity will be charged \$30 per night.

Rooms are allocated with preferred rates under the name of the Canadian Ski Patrol. Each individual or group must book their own accommodation. Rates are subject to availability at booking and applicable terms and conditions, fees and taxes. One additional night before and after the clinic weeks is available at these rates.

### EVENT HISTORY

This event has been organized by volunteers and offered at cost by the Canadian Ski Patrol Mountain Division annually since 1977 to provide top-level instruction to patrollers, family members, friends, trainees and potential new patrollers in a relaxed, convivial environment focused on learning and enjoyment.

### Refund Policy

Following several years of extraordinarily high cancellations we have implemented a refund policy (all times MDT):

- Prior to one month from event (Dec. 17, 2025, at midnight for Week 1, Dec. 31, 2025, at midnight for Week 2 and January 23, 2025, at midnight for Week 3): \$100 fee.
- One month from event to two days before (Jan. 15, 2026, at midnight for Week 1; January 30, 2025 at midnight for Week 2; Jan. 21, 2026 at midnight for Week 3): \$200 fee.
- After two days before the event (Jan. 16, 2026 at midnight for Week 1; Jan. 29 at midnight for Week 2; Feb. 19 at midnight for Week 3): No refund.
- Individual lift tickets: \$20.
- Event components that cannot be held: full refund.

Refunds are calculated and applied at the sole discretion of the organizer.
